| | Merit Cum Means Scholarship For Professional and Technical Courses CS | Students who have secured not less than 50% marks or equivalent grade in the previous final examination and the annual income of whose parents/guardians from all sources does not exceed Rs.2.50 lakh. | 31-10-2020 |
| Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment | Top Class Education Scheme for SC Students | <p>Annual family income from all sources up to Rs. 6 Lakh and having secured admission in a full-time course.</p> <p>In case the number of eligible students admitted exceeds the number of slots allotted to the institutions, the scholarship will be restricted to the top students in the inter-se merit list based on the admission criteria for the course.</p> <p>In case the institution finds that the number of eligible candidates in the 1st year are less than the number of slots allotted to it, the balance slots may be offered to eligible students studying in 2nd, 3rd and 4th year, etc on the basis of inter-se merit of previous year's result.</p> <p>30% of slot allotted to the institution shall be reserved for the eligible SC girl students as per their inter-se merit.</p> <p>The benefit of the scheme will not be provided to more than 2 siblings in a family.</p> | 31-10-2020 |

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| <p>Department of School Education & Literacy</p> | <p>National Means Cum Merit Scholarship</p> | <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. An awardee is eligible for the scholarship provided he/she takes up studies in approved courses. 2. Maintains good conduct as certified by the Head of the College/Institution and continues his/her studies as a regular student in a Government/Government-aided /Local Body school. 3. Does not take up any job. 4. No scholarship shall be available for studies abroad for any course. 5. No claim for scholarship arrears will be entertained after the expiry of 12 months of the academic session for which one has applied for the claim. 6 In case any awardee leaves his/her course of study within one month of registration/admission, no scholarship shall be paid to him/her. 7. The awardee must join the next class/desired course within 3 months of the declaration of the result of the previous class/course. 8. Scholarship shall be deemed to be discontinued with any gap of one academic session in studies at any time due to any reason. 9. 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| <p>Department of Higher Education</p> | <p>Central Sector Scheme of Scholarships For College And University Students</p> | <p>Students who are above 80th percentile of successful candidates in the relevant stream from the respective Board of Examination in Class XII of 10+2 pattern or equivalent and pursuing regular courses (not correspondence or distance mode) in Colleges/Institutions recognized by All India Council of Technical Education, UGC Act, 1956, Medical Council of India, Dental Council of India and respective regulatory authorities and not availing benefit of any other scholarship scheme including State run scholarship schemes/Fee waiver and reimbursement scheme are eligible under the scheme.</p> | <p>31-10-2020</p> |
| <p>North Eastern Council (NEC) Do NER</p> | <p>Financial Support To The Students of NER For Higher Professional Courses (NEC Merit Scholarship)</p> | <p>The scholarship is open only to a student who is a permanent resident of any of the North Eastern States.</p> <p>For candidates belonging to Academic Year 2020-21 and onwards, the scholarship under this scheme shall be disbursed only through National Scholarship Portal (NSP).</p> <p>HSLC/HSSLC/Secondary School Leaving /Senior Secondary Leaving certificate examination from a recognized State/Central board with minimum 60% marks in aggregate.</p> <p>HSSLC/Senior Secondary Leaving certificate examination from a recognized State/Central board with minimum 60% marks in aggregate.</p> <p>Degree level examination in any discipline (BA/BSc/BE/B Tech/MBBS/LLB/BCA/BBA etc. of any recognized Institute/ University with minimum 60% marks in aggregate.</p> <p>PG degree from any recognized University with minimum 60% marks in aggregate.</p> | <p>31-10-2020</p> |

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| <p>Ministry of Tribal Affairs</p> | <p>National Fellowship and Scholarship for Higher Education of ST Students – Scholarship (Formally Top Class Education for Schedule Tribe Students) – only for scholarships</p> | <p>1.1 The candidate belonging to ST should have passed the Post-Graduation examination. The candidate should get admission and registration for regular and full time M.Phil/Ph.D Courses in University/ Institution.</p> <p>1.2 The ST students once considered eligible for the Fellowship shall not be entitled for any other scholarship of the Centre or State Government the same study.</p> <p>1.3 For Senior Research Fellowship a candidate will have to fulfill the UGC/ICAR norms.</p> <p>2.1 ST students who have secured admission in the notified Institutions according to the norms prescribed by the respective Institutions will be eligible for the scholarship under the scheme.</p> <p>2.2 The total family income from all sources should not exceed Rs.6.0 lakh per annum.</p> | <p>31-10-2020</p> |
| <p>Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities</p> | <p>Pre-matric Scholarship for Students with Disabilities</p> <p>Post-matric Scholarship for Students with Disabilities</p> <p>Scholarships for Top Class Education for students with disabilities.</p> | <p>Students with disabilities with 40% and above and having a valid certificate.</p> <p>Not more than two children with disabilities of the same parents will be entitled to receive benefits.</p> <p>Scholarship for studying in any class will be available for only one year.</p> <p>Scholarship holder under this scheme will not hold any other scholarship/stipend.</p> | <p>31-10-2020</p> |
