


Principal's Message

A Brief History of M.G.M Down the Lane



With the Blessings of our Lord Jesus Christ and prayers of Mother Mary, St. Mary's Nursery School, under our Church St. Mary's Orthodox Church at Bokaro Steel City, which started under the leadership of Fr. P.T. Cherian in the year of 1976 became one of the prestigious nursery Schools in Bokaro District. As a result of modern teaching technology adopted by the school under the leadership of efficient Parish Priests and dedicated teachers, the School became very popular among all other nursery Schools in Bokaro Steel City. From the very beginning, there were tremendous rush and demand for admissions in the School.

During 1980's, it was very difficult to get admissions to students in Schools in Bokaro Steel City for all classes. Children of our own Parish members were facing this problem; though there were several Christian schools in the steel city. Keeping this in mind and by seeing the success of our nursery Schools, God motivated few of our senior parish members to go for a Higher Secondary School in the Steel City. Thus they sat together with the Parish Priest Rev. Fr. O. Thomas and seriously discussed the matter in detail and decided to have a Higher Secondary School to be named as MAR GREGORIOS MEMORIAL SCHOOL.

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As the decision was under the will of Almighty God, though few church members initially persuaded to drop higher secondary school project idea, based on the firm decision taken by the Parish Priest Fr. O. Thomas and with the support of few well-wishers of the Church, matter got conveyed to the then Diocesan Metropolitan Bishop Dr. Stephanos Mar Theodosius at Bhilai and got approval to go ahead with the Higher Secondary School project in the name of 'Parumala Kochu Thirumeni'. Though finance was the main problem, financial support came as loans from few senior church members to start the work.

Parents of students of St. Mary's Nursery School whole – heartily welcomed the Church decision for the new Secondary School and assured their full support and cooperation to the project. They wanted to get their children admitted in nursery classes in St. Mary's School and get automatically transferred to Higher Secondary School under the same management without much hardship of running for admission elsewhere. Actually, this thought of the parents became really a boost to the Parish members for initiating quick action for implementing the school project.

Parish members applied to Bokaro Steel Plant Authorities for a piece of land in Sector IV of the Steel City for the School Project. By the blessings of Almighty God, a beautiful plot in the School Zone area in Sector IV/F was allotted and the project work started soon after land allotment formalities were completed under the leadership of Fr. O. Thomas and foundation stone laid by the then Diocese Metropolitan Bishop Dr. Stephanos Mar Theodosius.

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As soon as the Higher Secondary School building construction began, admissions for Standard I & II started during 1984 – 86 academic years in St. Mary's School building, i. e Morning session for Nursery and afternoon for Std. I & II. Response from parents of the students was tremendous and very encouraging.

Design and Drawings for the building adopted was the same as of MGM School at Bhilai. The school building work 1st part completed very fast in a miraculous manner and during 1988 MGM Higher Secondary School opened for admission of Students from Standard 1 to X.

Subsequently, MGM School became MGM Senior Secondary School with Plus I & II Residents of Bokaro Steel City and the adjacent City Chas welcomed the School and they were relieved of a big burden of children's education.

Few Buses were purchased for transportation of students. Qualified and well – experienced teachers got recruited. Day – by – Day MGM School started growing up and soon became strong enough to compete with any other major schools of the Steel City in education.


Approval from CBSE Authorities came fast after successful completion of all required formalities and facility.

The then Catholicos of The East and our Supreme Head, H.H. Moran Mar Baselios Marthoma Mathews II, when visited our Parish and our Schools knew that total membership strength of the Parish is only a few, But after seeing MGM School projects and facilitates available there exclaimed that 'WHAT I SEE HERE IS A MIRACLE OF PARUMALA KOCHU THIRUMENI'!! (Our Patron Saint).

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Today, MGM Higher Secondary School at Bokaro Steel City is one of the main School Projects under Calcutta Diocese in all respects. The initial hard work by few of the Senior Church Members and Parish Priests are to be mentioned here with thanks. Stern decisions and actions from the then Diocesan Metropolitan Bishop Late Lamented Dr. Stephanos Mar Theodosius, help from Bokaro Steel Plant Management and School Committees are to be appreciated and acknowledged for bringing up MGM School in today's status. Proper control, timely advices, close involvement and implementing valuable decisions in all activities for the smooth and successful running of M.G.M H S School, B.S. City, by the present Calcutta Diocesan Metropolitan Bishop His Grace Dr. Joseph Mar Dionysius is to be remembered and appreciated with gratitude. Our present Bishop, His Grace Dr. Joseph Mar Dionysius, gives new ideas for the improvement of our school in all aspects. Parish Priests and all Principals, who all are involved and worked hard for the betterment of Church and School Projects from starting till today are to be appreciated and thanked for their valuable contribution.

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Senior members of the Church have worked hard for bringing up of the school in today's position and they are continuing their assistance from time to time based on the need of the situation.

The Church and School Management are thankful to Bokaro Steel Plant Management and people of the area for their valuable support and help to run the School effectively and efficiently.

A Delightful Journey Down the Memory Lane




Fr. O. Thomas (1986-1988)

A profound scholar with self-reliance, discipline & determination and worked to overcome the infancy of school during his tenure.

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


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*Fr. Kurian Abraham (1991-1994;




Late Fr. Commen Punnoose (1994-1995)

A simple, gentle, hardworking, systematic and soft person, who worked meticulously for the institute from 1999-2002.




Prof. K. C. Mami (2002-2005)

Mar Gregorios Memorial Higher Secondary School, Bokaro Steel City, which had a humble beginning at St. Mary's Nursery school in the year 1986, shifted to the present location in 1988. To commemorate its 30 years of Glorious existence in the present location, Pearl Jubilee celebration was organized on 29th & 30th November 2018. It was a mega event in which the entire students and staff members of the school enthusiastically participated. It also formed a ground for the first ever Alumni Meet of the school since its inception.

The grand function was inaugurated on 29th November by the renowned social activist and Ramon Magsaysay awardee Shri Bezwada Wilson, from Delhi. Special Guests for the event were Dr. Arvind C. Ranade, an eminent scientist in the ministry of Science and Technology New Delhi, Dr. Manmohan Singh Marwaha, retired Principal of Shri Guru Govind Singh College, Chandigarh and Mr. V.B Raigaonkar, retired District Science officer at District Science Centre, Dharampur. The school band escorted the guests with royal display to the stage. Fr. Reji. C.Varghese, Principal, then welcomed the dignitaries and the entire gathering. Mrs. Prabha Anthony Yadav, Vice principal, presented the school report and its achievements in the last 30 years. Three former Principals- Very. Rev George Mathew Ramban, Rev Fr. Kurian Abraham and Mr. Regi Oommen and three Ex- Vice Presidents Rev. Fr. Shaji. M. Baby, Rev Fr. James. Gee Varghese and Rev. Fr. In English corners, secondary and senior secondary students enacted the Shakespearean Drama. More than 200 models and multiple charts were displayed There were live Science Corners where Dr. Manmohan Singh Marwaha and Shri V.B Raigaonkar demonstrated and explained scientific reasons behind different scientific principles to Students and Parents. Apart from our school, students and teachers of the surrounding schools also visited the exhibition and interacted with the key resource persons. 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
An Inter School Science Model Competition “**Arunoday**”, was held in the school Auditorium in which 15 schools participated.


My Life's Experience


All about My School!

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

The first day of the Pearl Jubilee Celebration witnessed a plethora of activities. This model making exhibition was to harness the creativity and innovative spirit within the students. The competition was based on the main theme, “*Changing Trends in Science and Technology*”. There were sub topics such as Agriculture, Robotics, Smart Energy, Technology in Health, Smart Apps, Smart Technology in Recycle and Reuse products, on which the students were asked to make their presentations. Three students from each school were allowed to participate as a team. The exhibit/model/project were either a working model or an investigation based project related to the theme. Total 13 schools from Bokaro registered for the exhibition and out of which 9 schools participated. In the competition, the jury adjudged Delhi Public School Bokaro as 1st, Crescent Public School as 2nd and St. Xavier School as 3rd. Farming in India:

Since India is an agriculture-based country, majority of its population is based on agriculture for their livelihood. Approx. 25% of India's GDP is from agriculture sector.

Condition of farmers:

Farmers of our country face many problems like Agrarian Crisis and many more which leads to a great loss not only to them but also to the country. They are mostly illiterate and are not aware of how to reduce this loss.

Problems faced by farmers:

So, a survey was conducted in our locality to figure out their problems. Majority of them have the following woes:-

- ❖ INEFFECTIVE PROTECTION OF CROPS FROM STRAY ANIMALS AND BIRDS.
- ❖ IMPROPER GRAIN STORAGE SYSTEM.
- ❖ IMPROPER IRRIGATION SYSTEM.
- ❖ IMPROPER BORING AND WATER STORAGE FACILITY.
- ❖ CROP DAMAGE DUE TO FIRE.
- ❖ LACK OF ENVIROMENTAL KNOWLEDGE.

Our solutions:-

1. Farm security

- Use of microcontroller (Arduino -Mega 256) which will act as CPU.
- It will control the other hardware devices.
- Fencing of farm using a USSR developed method which works on the principal of SONAR.
- Use Of IR-Proximity sensor as scarecrow

2. Smart water irrigation, storage and boring system

- We will attach a moisture sensor with our submersible pump that will auto-cut the electric supply of the motor when water level is low using a relay module and overflow of water will also be prevented.
- We will attach a moisture sensor to the field, so that, if the water level is low in the soil it will inform the farmer and if it's high it will turn the motor off.

3. Grain storage

- We are using a PIR -Sensor that senses infrared radiations emitted by animals and humans.
- This will protect crops from rodents and thieves.
- We will also install a gas sensor in the field and the storage for fire protection.



Simplified weather monitoring system: -

- We have made a simplified weather monitoring system that will tell about the temperature and humidity.
- This will help farmer to decide the amount of water to be given in irrigation and hence prevent over-irrigation.

Efficiency of our project: -

- Although our project is very simple, it is hi-tech and organic.
- After its installation, farmers have to just turn the system on or off by just pressing a switch.
- This will help farmers to save their losses made in a season.
- The cost of this project is 15,000 including the whole setup - submersible pump, wiring and installation.
- If we compare the whole year loss of a farmer to this it is less costly as it will prevent the loss.
- Approx.*12 crore of crops are destroyed in fire, stolen by thieves, etc.
- Our project will save this loss and help farmers.

Our experience:-


